



Fundraising for Poor Orphans in South Africa



- Girls in South Africa are vulnerable to rape, teenage pregnancies and murder
- According to UNICEF, more than 50% of South African children live in poverty
- 1.7 million live in shacks with no adult carer or basic home provision
- 330,000 children of school-going age do not attend school due to poverty - the majority are girls.

History

Apartheid has left South Africa a divided society and a very unequal one. In most towns and cities, the landscape still shows a society with huge inequalities and stark differences between rich and poor.

A typical South African town has a formerly white area where the central business district is situated, which is well developed and compares with any developed country.

On the outskirts of the developed parts of town, you will typically find formerly Black and Indian townships with much lower levels of development and few health facilities.

Facilities are reduced, the more remote the townships; where running water is sometimes only available from a community 'standpipe'.

The Aids death rate is high among 20-50 year olds; resulting in a high number of orphaned children. Very few have family to rescue or provide for them. There is no welfare system so orphan children live rough or on the streets in severely impoverished conditions.

4W2W have been supporting poor women and children in South Africa for over 7 years now. Charities like us are their only hope for a future and the basics, which are; **love, food, clothing, education and shelter.**
